Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects

BACK TO SCHOOL SUPPLY CUPS



MATERIALS

DB31529 Modern Tumbler
Medium Brush
Liner Brush
Detail Brush
Marker
1/2" Tape
1/4" Tape

COLORS

CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 48 - Guacamole
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 70 - Star Dust
CMM 72 - Sahara
CMM 19 - Banana Boat
CMM 93 - London Fog
CMM 3 - Carnation
CMM 47 - Deep Sea
CMM 43 - Saffire

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INSTRUCTIONS

Marker Cup:

1. We are going to use tape to mask off the sections. You could also sketch them out and paint them in if you'd like.
2. Working from the bottom of the cup up. Every where you put tape down will end up white, and the open spaces will end up being painted.
 - a. Put a piece of 1/2" tape .25" from the bottom and wrap it around.
 - b. Leave a space about 1/2" inch from the last piece and wrap it around.
 - c. Put another piece of tape directly above that one and wrap it around making a 1" band around the middle.
 - d. Leave a space about 1/2" from the last piece of tape and wrap it around.
3. Now that it's taped up we are going to paint the sections in. The ring around the base will get 1-2 coats of London Fog.
4. The remaining sections and the inside will be your marker color. We did 3 coats of Guacamole.
5. When the paint starts to dry, remove your tape.
6. Make a wavy line on top of the two green lines using a liner brush and 2 coats of Snowflake.
7. Add some water to Licorice paint and make thin broken outlines between the "cap" and the marker, then another one above the grey line.

Crayon Cup:

1. We are going to use tape to mask off the sections. You could also sketch them out and paint them in if you'd like.
2. Every where you put tape down will end up the light blue, and the open spaces will be filled in with other colors:
 - a. Put a piece of 1/4" tape about .25" from the bottom and wrap it around.
 - b. Leave a space about 1/2" from the last piece and wrap it around.
 - c. Put a piece of 1/4" tape about .25" from the top and wrap it around.
 - d. Leave a space about 1/2" from the last piece and wrap it around.
 - e. Wrap tape around the remaining middle so it's all blocked off.
3. Paint the inside, top band, and bottom band with 3 coats of Saffire.
4. Next, paint in the remaining two bands with 3 coats of Licorice. When the paint begins to dry remove the paint.
5. Use 3 coats of Deep Sea to fill in the bands left after removing the tape.
6. Make a wavy line on top of the two black lines with a liner brush and 2 coats of Deep Sea.
7. Add some water to Licorice paint and make thin broken outlines between the two dark bands and the lighter blue bands.

Pencil Cup:

1. We are going to use tape to mask off some of the sections.
 - a. Leave about 1/8" at the top of the cup and place on 1/2" strip of tape.
 - b. Put a 1/2" tape around the bottom of the cup.
 - c. Leave a space of about 1/4" from the last piece of tape and put on another strip of 1/2" paint.
2. Paint the top band on the cup and the inside with 3 coats of Star Dust.
3. Paint in the band near the bottom of the cup with 3 coats of London Fog.
4. Remove the tape. Use your marker to draw a zig zag line around 1/2" down from the Star Dust.
5. Paint the section above the zig zag line with 3 coats of Sahara.
6. Next, fill in the band at the very bottom of the cup with 3 coats of Carnation.
7. Fill in the remaining part of the cup with 3 coats of Banana Boat.
8. Add some water to some Licorice paint and create a messy broken outline across the zig zag line, and around the little grey band.

For all of the cups, write in the word with marker and then paint them on with 1 coat of Licorice.

TIPS

- Refer to the photos to help you visualize where the paint is going to go.
- Don't stress over the lines being perfect, create messy broken lines as not to detract from the writing.

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
