

CHRISTMAS TREE SNACK CAKE BOX



MATERIALS

DB21690 Cake Box
Fan Brush
Medium Brush
Small Brush
Liner Brush
Water-based Marker
Writer Bottle in CMM 90

COLORS

CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 90 - Red Hot
CMM 72 - Sahara
SG 704 - Speckta-Clear
Peppermint



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Thin down Snowflake paint by mixing 50% water with 50% paint.
- 2. Use a fan brush to apply 2 coats of the watered-down Snowflake paint to the top of the lid.
- 3. Next, use a small brush to apply 2 coats of the watered-down Snowflake to the line of "icing" on the base of the box.
- 4. Use a writer bottle filled with Red Hot and make the lines on the lid. You can use the liner brush to smooth out the lines if you need to.
- 5. Apply 3 coats of Sahara to the two "cake" sections on the base of the box.
- 6. When the lid is completely dry, use a fan brush to apply one coat of the Speckta-Clear Peppermint to the top and edges of the lid.
- 7. When the lid is dry, flip it over and paint the entire underside of the lid with 3 coats of Snowflake paint (not watered down).
- ** The lid will not be dipped in a clear glaze after using the Speckta-Clear Peppermint, so make sure all the pottery is coated with 3 coats of Snowflake on the underside.
- ** The base of the box will be dipped into clear glaze.

TIPS

- If you'd like, you can use a water-based marker to sketch the lines on the lid before painting them.
- If you do not have the Speckta-Clear Peppermint, you can achieve the speckled look by flicking on red and green spots using a stiff brush or a toothbrush.
